To solve Bible Verse Boxes, drop the letters from each vertical column – not necessarily in the order in which they appear – into the empty squares below them to spell a familiar Bible verse reading from left to right, line by line. Words may continue from one line to the next; black squares indicate ends of words. The book from which each verse is taken is shown above its grid. Punctuation has been omitted.
