

- 6. What part of the temple was the first to be rebuilt?
- 7. Who was appointed governor by King Cyrus to return the gold and silver that Nebuchadnezzar had taken from the temple and to rebuild the house of God?
- 8. Who was the king of Persia who overthrew Babylon, and permitted the exiles to return to Judah and ordered the temple to be rebuilt?
- 9. Who was the son of Jozadak who helped rebuild the altar?
- 10. Who was the son of Jehoiachin who was appointed governor of Judah and led the first group of exiles back home and led the effort to rebuild the temple?
