

Grief Group

The Grief Group at First Presbyterian Church has eleven members and they sit in a circle in seats one through eleven as shown in the accompanying diagram. Using the clues below, can you determine who sits where and for whom each person is grieving?

1. Eight of the members are women.
2. The men in the group sit next to each other.
3. Two members include a mother and her daughter, and two other members include a mother and her son.
4. The names of the members are Chris, David, Evar, Karen, Karlin, Nancy, Pamela, Pat, Renee, RJ, and Sharon.
5. They are grieving for nine people: Bob, Carol, Craig, Ginny, Jason, Lee, Margaret, Mike, and Thomas.
6. Karlin and the person grieving for Bob lived next door to each other for years and they are sitting next to each other in the group.
7. One of the two women grieving for Jason sits in seat #1.
8. The woman sitting in seat #11 is grieving for her mother-in-law, Margaret, and is one of the two leaders of the group. The other leader sits across from her in seat #5 and is grieving for her husband Thomas.
9. Evar sits between her mother and Karlin.
10. One of the leaders sits between Karen and David, and the other leader sits between Sharon and the woman who is grieving for Mike.
11. Pat is grieving for her son Craig and she sits in seat #7.
12. The man grieving for Carol sits two seats away from Chris, who is grieving for his brother.
13. RJ is grieving for his wife and sits between David and Chris.
14. Nancy sits between Pat and Pamela.
15. Sharon sits between the person grieving for Lee and the person grieving for Thomas.
16. The person grieving for Ginny is sitting in seat #9.
